The Mat-Su Construction Academy introduces adults, 18 and over, to careers in the construction trades. The application process is as follows:

Complete an application form. A copy of your most recent resume must be included with the application. On the resume, there needs to be at least 2 professional references. The Mat-Su Job Center, or myself will provide resume writing assistance if needed.

Submitting math, reading and locating WorkKeys test scores is required. The Job Center provides these tests for free. You can walk in at any time to begin the first step which is to take the Career Ready 101 pretests for all three areas. After completing the pretests and achieving a minimum of level 4 in each subject area you can contact Connie Williams at (907) 352-2508 to schedule an appointment for the WorkKeys test.

Application packets, which must include application, test scores, and resume with two references, should be submitted to the Mat-Su Home Builder's Office, or the Job Center. Applications are accepted year round, but classes are only offered in the fall, winter, and spring.

All people who submit complete application packets will be offered an interview for class placement. Class size is limited, entry is competitive, and you may, or may not be selected. The classes are free, so we want to be sure we get the best applicants. If you are not selected, you will be put on a waiting list.
